User name: enter your user name

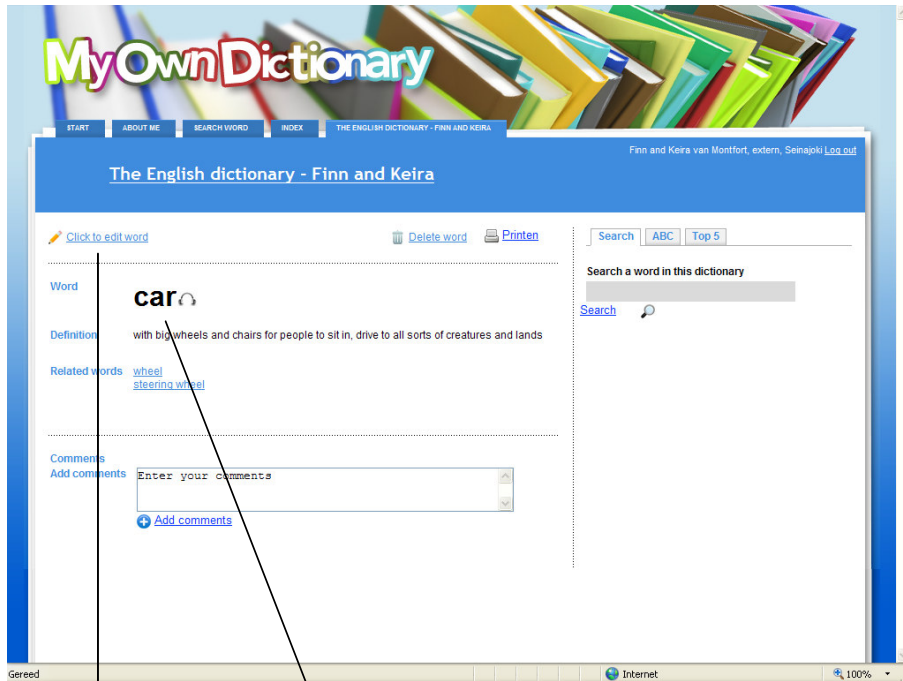
Password: enter your password

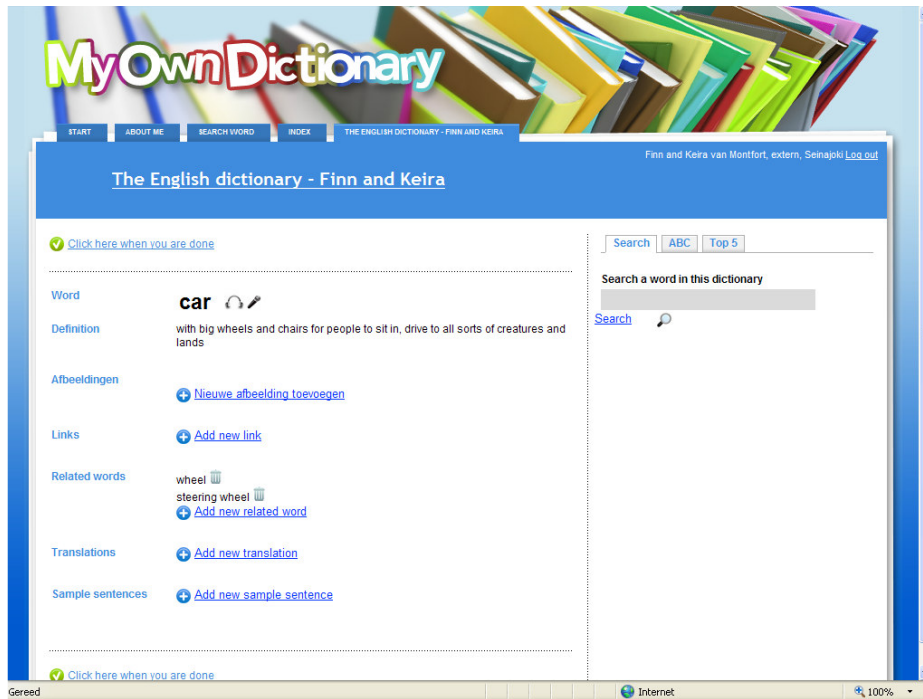
2. We are going to start adding or completing words!

- Choose a word to put into your dictionary
- Go to “Add a new word to this dictionary”
- Enter the word.
- Click on Add word
- Ready! Your word has shown up, and you can enter your data



This is your word.

Click at: *Click to edit word*. You can enter all kinds of data right now.



Click at "Add definition" to describe the word.

Click at "Add new picture" to add one or more images.

Flip through your data files, and search for a proper image, possible using Google. Save the image at your computer. Add the image at the dictionary.

Click at “*Add new link*” to create a link to the internet if there is a site related to your word: e.g. information, a film or a sound.

Click at “*Add new related word*” to add a word which is related to your word. You can add more words if you want to. Add those words one by one, and save every word.

Click at “*Add new translation*” if you know this word in another language. In the list you can choose the language you are searching for. Add the word, and save it.



By clicking at the microphone, you can pronounce the word. Pronounce the word, and click at save.

Click at “*Add new sample sentence*”. Add a sentence with your word. If your word has several meanings, than add more sample sentences with these different meanings.

Ready! Click at “*Click here when you are done*”.

Your word is totally completed now.

If you have pronounced the word, you can see a headphone near the word. If you click at the headphone, you can hear the pronunciation.
